Leapers are very supportive of their classmates and their accomplishments.

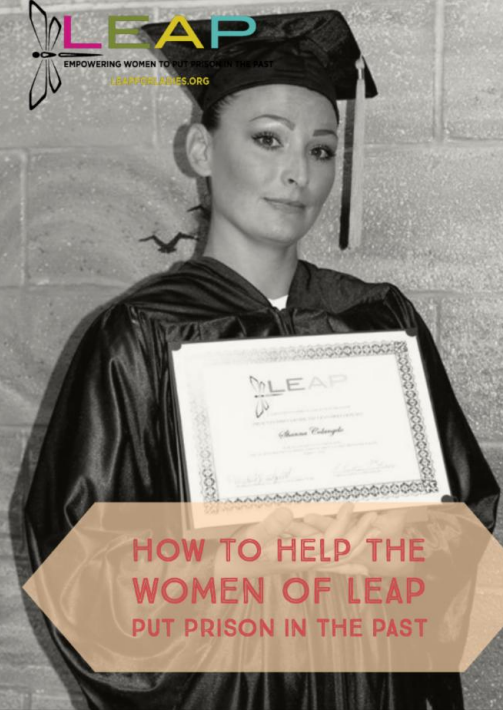
With Gratitude ...

Attend one of our information nights held the second Thursday of every month from 6 - 7 pm. The next one is July 12! RSVP through our Facebook Event.

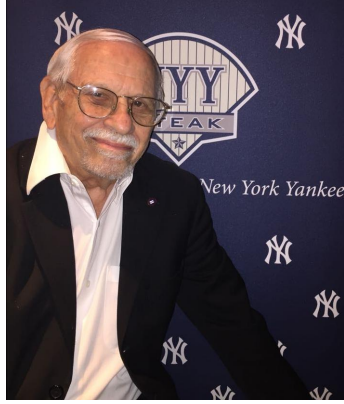
Meet Kim, LEAP Class 15

Kim was released from prison just one month ago, and already she has a safe and comfortable place to live (at the Sacred House) and a job. Through her paid internship at LEAP's Dragonfly Thrift Boutique she is learning new skills, attending yoga classes, meeting new people interested in her success, had her first modeling gig, and participated in Galvanize Florida -- her first conference ever.

"The day I got out of prison I and came to the store I said 'wow, this is where I'm going to be working now... I can't believe it!' The way I felt that day was amazing, and then I went to the house and it's nice and I have my own room - I love it and I love the people. This is all a whole new life experience and I'm incredibly glad I made the decision to choose LEAP and follow through."
