Thanks to several community partners, all of us can sleep a bit better. Camillus House and Chapman Partnership agreed to take in our ladies who have no where else to go, and have already welcomed four graduates this past year. Lotus House has also opened its doors to LEAPers coming out of prison and we expect some of our ladies will go there in 2017.

Transitions, Inc. has placed several of our ladies in jobs and has promised to do the same in 2017. Transitions, Inc. works with local employers to show them that hiring ex-offenders can make great business sense, is good for the community AND is an amazing opportunity to make a huge difference in the life of someone looking for a second chance. If you are in the market to hire someone, please ask us about employer incentives for hiring ex-offenders.

The Center For Social Change, which has supported LEAP in a thousand different ways over the years, has come through in a huge way for 2017. Thanks to the Center, as of January 1, we now have a house where several LEAP graduates can live until they get on their feet. The house is located in a safe neighborhood near the Center (which is also where LEAP's office is located) and public transportation.
